JISC is working with QCA to develop 20 case studies of innovative and effective practice in the use of e-assessment across the UK education sector. The case studies will also explore the challenges and benefits of e-assessment, together with the institutional, operational and pedagogic enablers and barriers to effective use of ICT in assessment.

The studies will be aimed primarily at practitioners in the 4-19, post-16 and HE sectors but are likely to be of value to other key stakeholders, including funding and regulatory bodies, strategic partners and examining boards.

This session will explore the criteria for selecting the case studies and participants will have the opportunity to contribute ideas to what key issues and areas of practice the case studies should look to address.
